

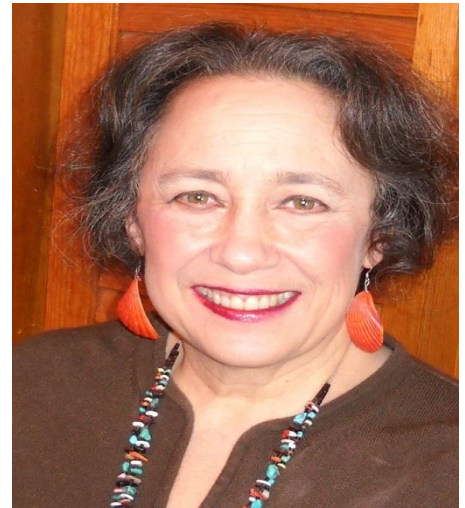
Multisensory Math I & II Online and Onsite Courses
